Mrs. Manisali-Darman is a graduate of Management from Middle East Technical University, Turkey, and has an MBA in Finance. She was the Executive Director of ICC Turkish National Committee from 1980 to 1988. She then worked as the CFO and acting CEO of eminent groups in private sector. She set up her own advisory company, GMD Global Advisors Ltd. in 2005, with a group of eligible partners, in the field of corporate governance related services ranging from assessment to research and from raising awareness to compliance. She is the Founder, Senior Partner and Principal of Corporate Governance and Sustainability Center in Turkey.

Currently, she is the Vice-Chair of the ICC (International Chamber of Commerce) Commission on Financial Services and Insurance, and also Liaison Officer of American European Community Association- Brussels (AECA), in Turkey.

She is a member of the European Corporate Governance Institute (ECGI), and Corporate Governance Association of Turkey. She is one of the founding members of (Junior Chamber International) JCI Turkey, founder of Ankara LOM, and a Senator at the JCI International. Mrs. Manisali-Darman also lectures on corporate governance in Middle East Technical University, and TOBB University of Economics and Technology in Ankara.
