

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES

Jukka Seppälä

Vice President, Stakeholder Relations and Trade Policy, Metso Corporation

Mr. Jukka Seppälä (born 1949) has served Metso Corporation and its predecessor companies since 1984 in various functions related to international trade and global operations. In his present capacity he supports Metso's businesses in growth markets on issues related to business opportunities, trade policy and market access.

Metso is a global supplier of sustainable technology and services for mining, construction, power generation, automation, recycling and the pulp and paper industries, with 28,000 employees in more than 50 countries (www.metso.com).

Prior to joining Metso Mr Seppälä worked from 1977 to 1984 for the company Labsystems in marketing and export sales of medical technology.

Between 1973 and 1977 he was employed by the Finnish Ministry for Foreign Affairs where he worked in the Trade Policy Department, and was involved in issues of international technical, scientific and economic cooperation.

He is currently Chairman of the Trade Policy Committee of the Confederation of Finnish Industries. Since 2007 he has been a member of the National Export Forum, an advisory body for export policies under the Ministry of Employment and Economy of Finland.

As from beginning of 2009 he is the Chairman of the ICC Finnish National Commission on Business in Society.

Mr Seppälä participates in the activities of several bilateral trade associations and chambers, and is the current Chairman of the Finland – Republic of Korea Trade Association, Vice-Chairman of the Finland – China Trade Association, the Finland – ASEAN Trade Association and the Finnish – Latin American Trade Association.

His other positions include membership of the Advisory Board of the WWF (World Wildlife Fund) Finland, and membership of the Board of Plan International (Finland).

He graduated from the Helsinki School of Economics and Business Administration in 1974.
